In order to assist in finding a solution, we include the perspectives of all parties involved in the issue wherever possible. We cooperate with various counselling facilities and institutions in the Rheinisch-Bergisch district as well as other educational psychological services. If necessary, we can provide further assistance and contact persons for those seeking advice.

Advice for pupils and their parents

Learning and performance, e.g.

- General learning disabilities
- Reading/spelling difficulties
